## Vestry Meeting Minutes

The Vestry met briefly on 6/2/19 after the 10:00am service. Purpose of this meeting was to discuss repair of the parking lot and also a request by an outside group to use our kitchen.

- 1) Vestry members were provided with 2 quotes for parking lot repairs. One quote was from Land-On the other from Autumn Paving. Both quotes were extensive and offered several different levels of work. The Vestry discussed and agreed that the cost of all options was more than we are able to spend right now, especially since the parking lot will be a priority in our upcoming Capital drive. Bob Mesmer suggested that we look at patching the areas most needed. He and parishioner Josh McConkey went outside and measured for square footage of just these areas. Ellen Valvo to contact these companies for estimate of repairing only these areas.
- 2) Ellen Valvo reported that she was contacted by Tom Thompson of the GI Farm Association (uncertain of exact name). This group is looking for a kitchen space to rent in order to prepare food items that they are selling at the weekly GI Farmer's Market. After discussion, the following motion was made:

The GI Farmer's Market group may use the kitchen at St. Martin's 1 day a week until the weekly Farmer's Market schedule is completed in October. Use must be after all Jack and Jill Preschool children have left the building. St. Martin's to request rental fee of \$50 per week.

Vestry members unanimously voted in favor. Ellen Valvo to contact Tom Thompson to discuss.
